

GLLKA 2010 Great Lakes Maritime Education Workshop

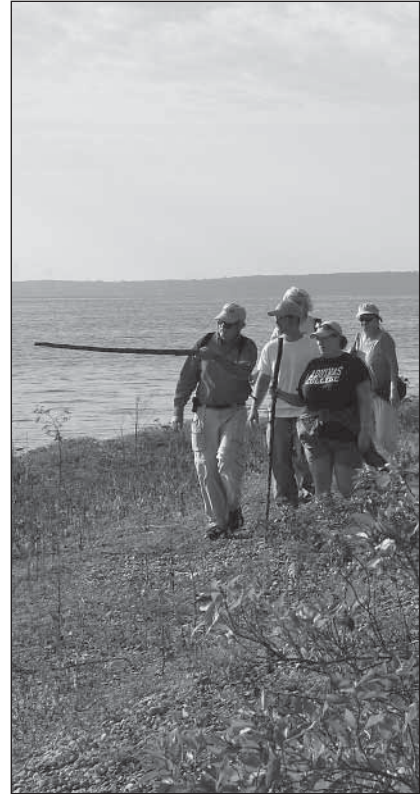
Wednesday July 14 through Sunday July 18, 2010

The GLLKA education department will again be sponsoring the Great Lakes Maritime Education Workshop at the St. Helena Island Light Station. The dates for this teacher-training program will be July 14th to July 18th. In its 19th year, this program offers 2 graduate credits of education from Central Michigan University and 3 SB-CEU's from the Eastern Upper Peninsula Intermediate School District.

Hands-on activities, in the areas of science, social studies, language arts, and math, will concentrate on the Great Lakes,

transportation, maritime history, and lighthouses. Music will also be a focus of the program. Each lesson meets the Grade Level Content Expectations (GLCE's) that have been set by the State of Michigan.

The staff for this exciting program are past participants of the Maritime Heritage Education Workshop and hold a variety of graduate degrees. They volunteer their time and expertise to provide a quality education program for both teachers, adult youth leaders and anyone with a passion for Great Lakes lighthouses and maritime history.

The program fee is \$275.00 and partially pays for educational materials, food, and housing at the St. Helena Island Light Station. Placement in the workshop will be on a first come-first served basis. The workshop size is limited to 12 students. The GLLKA will subsidize the majority of the cost, including boat transportation from Mackinaw City to the island and return.
